NAME ON PACKET	SCIENTIFIC NAME	COMMENTS
Abelmoschus sagittifolius	Abelmoschus sagittifolius	Native rosella. Ornamental. Edible flowers, leaves, roots.
Black sesame	Sesamum indicum	Edible seed.
Brassica carinata	Brassica carinata	Old Women Meet & Gossip aka Ethiopian cabbage. Edible florets and leaves. Tall.
Carob, Ceratonia siliqua	Ceratonia siliqua	Hermaphrodite cultivar producing both male and female flowers.
Celtuce	Lactuca sativa var. augustana	Edible leaves, flowers. Tall.
Chilli Bishops Crown	Capsicum chinense	Medium hot. Edible leaves, fruit. Good in drought conditions.
Chilli Habanero	Capsicum chinense	Hot. Edible leaves, fruit. Good in drought conditions.
Chilli Thai Sun	Capsicum annum	Very hot. Edible leaves, fruit. Good in all conditions.
Chinese celery	Apium graveolens var. secalinum	Perennial. Edible leaves and seed.
Corchorus capsularis, white jute	Corchorus capsularis	Edible leaves. Highly nutritious summer crop.
Corchorus olitorius	Corchorus olitorius	Common jute. Edible leaves used to thicken sauces. Edible young pods often pickled. Summer crop.
Dai gai choi Wynnum Imperial	Brassica juncea var. foliosa	Bellis original cultivar. Decorative, edible leaves and flowers.
Dwarf okra	Abelmoschus esculentus	Edible young pods.
Dwarf snake bean	Vigna unguiculata	Cultivar grown in Cleveland, QLD for over 40 years. Prolific summer crop.
Eggplant Early Long Purple	Solanum melongena	Crops almost all year round at Bellis.
Fenugreek	Trigonella foenum-graecum	Aka methi, edible leaves, seed. Cool season crop/ green manure.
Gac, Momordica cochinchinensis	Momordica cochinchinensis	Edible flesh around seed is cooked. Vigorous vine, need to grow male and female plants, plus hand pollination. Autumn crop.
Garden pea, Massey Gem	Pisum sativum	Edible seedlings, young pods, seed.
Hauazontle	Chenopodium berlandieri	Edible leaves. Annual. Bellis is the sole source in QLD. Do not confuse with Fat Hen, C. album.

Hibiscus coccineus	Hibiscus coccineus	Texas Star. Edible leaves, flowers. Prefers wet soil. Perennial.
Kenaf, Hibiscus cannabinus	Hibiscus cannabinus	Edible flowers, leaves. Summer crop like rosella, needs moisture.
Kings salad, Cosmos caudatus	Cosmos caudatus	Edible leaves, flowers. Kings Salad recipe, see website: www.jerry-coleby-williams.net
Lagos spinach, Celosia argentea	Celosia argentea	Edible leaves. Annual, sow any month except June-July. Flowers can be dried.
Lilium grandiflorum	Lilium grandiflorum	Christmas lily. Edible bulbs. Perennial, 18 months to harvest.
Lima bean Civil War	Phaseolus lunatus	Climbing perennial. Edible seed.
Melon Honeydew	Cucumis melo	Vine, edible fruit.
Milk thistle, Silybum marianum	Silybum marianum	Edible leaves. Must have excellent drainage.
Mung bean	Vigna radiata	Compact, non-climbing. Edible young pods. Edible seed, either cooked or sprouted.
Naranjilla	Solanum quitoense	Perennial shrub with tart, edible fruit used in juicing. Combine with tzimbalo.
Pigeon pea inoculated	Cajanus cajan	Edible young leaves, flowers, young pods. Mostly cropped for seed. Inoculated.
Pumpkin Butternut	Cucurbita moschata	Edible shoot tips, leaves, flowers and fruit.
Pumpkin Kent	Cucurbita maxima	Edible shoot tips, leaves, flowers and fruit.
Purple mizuna	Brassica rapa var. niposinica	Edible leaves, flowers.
Snowpea Delta Matilda	Pisum sativum	Edible pods, seed, shoot tips. Tall, mildew-resistant Australian-bred.
Snowpea Yakumo	Pisum sativum	Edible pods, seed, shoot tips. Tall, extra large pods.
Solanum cheesmaniae	Solanum cheesmaniae	Dwarf tomato, miniature fruit. Indeterminate. Native to the Galapagos Islands. Heat and humidity tolerant. Bellis is sole source in QLD.
Solanum pimpinellifolium	Solanum pimpinellifolium	Small fruit, vigorous plant. Indeterminate. Native to Ecuador.
Spray millet	Setaria italica	Warm season grain, makes gluten-free flour.
Tomato Black Russian	Solanum lycopersicum	Indeterminate.

Tomato Lemon Drop	<i>Solanum lycopersicum</i>	Indeterminate. Low acidity, sweet.
Tomato Zesty	<i>Solanum lycopersicum</i>	Indeterminate. Low acidity, sweet.
Tzimbaló, <i>Solanum caripense</i>	<i>Solanum caripense</i>	Sprawling climber. Fruit juiced, combine with naranjilla.
Winter melon	<i>Benincasa hispida</i>	Long fruit. Edible leaves, flowers, fruit. Heat tolerant.
Wuhuu bean, Norfolk Is	<i>Lablab purpureus</i>	Vigorous perennial vine. Edible young pods. Edible seed. Original source HMS Bounty via Pitcairn then Norfolk Islands. Ideal crop in hot, dry climate.
